1- Operations:

- Standard and advanced operations on the horizontal and vertical recti including revisions

- Transpalpebral orbitotomy

2- Strabismology and Pediatric ophthalmology:

- Diagnosis, deciding the surgical plan, and follow up of patients with different strabismus entities, in particular complex motility disorders.
- Retinopathy of prematurity
- Imaging (digital wide field imaging with a RetCam III including fluorescein angiography, and hand-held spectral domain OCT)

3- Hereditary Eye Diseases:

 Diagnosis of retinal dystrophies including standard and advanced electrophysiology and psychophysics. Molecular genetics. Genetic counselling

4- Neuro-Ophthalmology:

 Diagnosis and follow up of patients with different neuro-ophthalmic disorders including electrophysiology and psychophysics.

5- General ophthalmology clinic:

• Examination, diagnosis, treatment, and follow up of different ophthalmic disorders.
